

Registration Checklist

Jack Russell Terrier Club of Canada

All forms in this application packet must be fully and accurately completed, and all items attached in order to process the registration of your terrier. Please use this checklist to be sure everything is in order before submitting your application.

If you require extra applications please photocopy all the forms that make up this application before filling in any of the data.

- Application Form** - with supporting documentation, completed, signed, and dated. Do not fold photographs! FAXes NOT accepted.

- JRTCC Membership.** If you are not a member, have you enclosed a separate membership application and membership fee? The application will be forwarded to the membership secretary for further processing.

- Photographs of Terrier** - Six photos, front, left(2x) and right(2x) sides, and rear. No Polaroids and Do NOT Fold.

- JRTCC Health Certificate** - must be completely filled out, signed, and dated by owner.

- JRTCC Veterinarian's Certificate** - must be completely filled out, signed, and dated by licensed veterinarian within 30 days of application. Submit the original only.

- Stud Certificate** - must be fully completed, signed, and dated by owner of sire at time of breeding.

- Pedigree** - minimum of three generations, with all the data required, signed, and dated by breeder.

- Spayed or Neutered Terriers** must submit a spay/neuter certification signed by a veterinarian.

- Registration Fee** - make cheques payable to JRTCC.

- If submitting **Trial or Certificate of Field Worthiness application(s)** at the same time, include the appropriate applications and fees. The applications will be forwarded to the Judges Committee for further processing and the hunting certificate will not be returned with your registration.

Your application WILL NOT BE PROCESSED unless ALL the above have been submitted correctly!
The only exceptions are spayed or neutered terriers.
