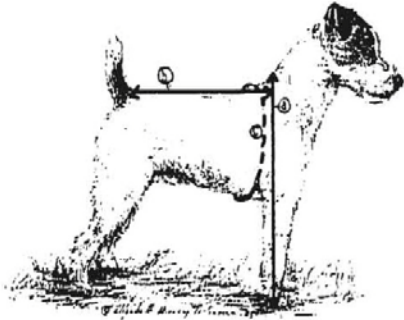

## MEASURING YOUR TERRIER

---

The diagram indicates how and where measurements should be taken. Please make every attempt to measure as accurately as possible; it is an important part of your dog's permanent records.



### A. Height Measurement.

Measured from highest point of the shoulder (withers) to the ground; most accurately obtained using a wicket. If a wicket is not available, a straight object (preferable with a level) should be placed across the back, and the measurement taken from that point to the ground using a yard stick or tape measure.

### B. Length of Back Measurement.

Measured from the base of the shoulder to the base of the tail; most accurately obtained using tape measure.

### C. Chest Measurement.

This measurement is the circumference of the widest point of the chest. Use a tape measure, wrapped completely around dog's body, behind front legs at the widest point of the chest. Pull tape tight to get most accurate measurement.
